It is a free e-mail service that updates you with news and information during disasters through your mobile phone

3 MAIN FUNCTIONS of MAMORU



1 Disaster Prevention Weather Information and Evacuation Advisories for Earthquakes / Tsunamis, Typhoons, and Heavy Rains

- Combining with regular weather information, information on earthquakes (seismic intensity of the quake), tsunamis (advisories and warnings), typhoons, advisories/warnings in the Prefecture can be received.
- Receive advisories from the Prefectural Government during disasters, as well as evacuation advisories and disaster information from local governments.

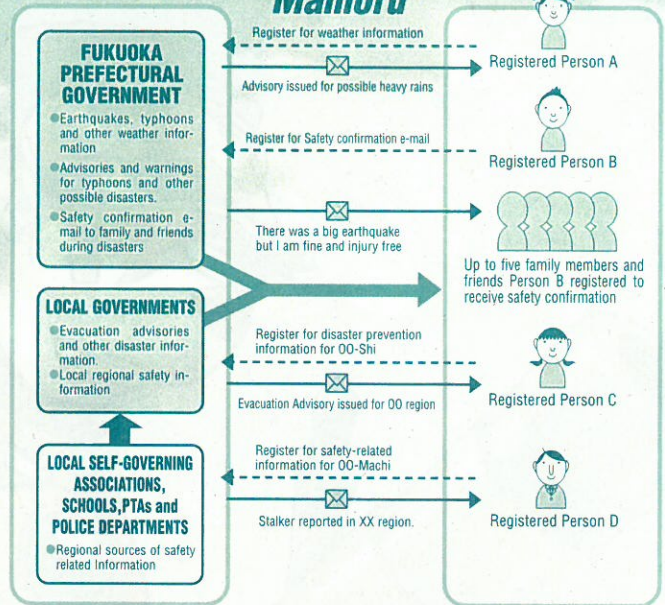
2 Safety Confirmation E-mails During Disasters

When registering with the service, you can register the mail addresses of the person(s) you would like to inform of your safety in the occurrence of a disaster. If an earthquake above 5 in Richter scale or a tsunami strikes the Prefecture, information regarding the earthquake or tsunami and a safety confirmation e-mail, which you can fill out, will be sent to you. The safety confirmation e-mail will then be forwarded to the person(s) you registered, so please follow the instructions and fill out the details accordingly

3 Local Regional Safety Information

Local Regional safety information provided by participating local governments will be sent to you.

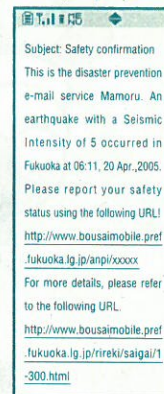
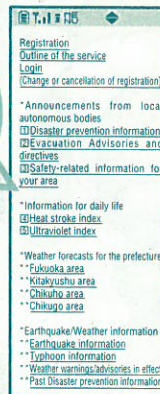
